Minutes of Executive Meeting held May 30th, 2005.

1. Elections that were held at the May Annual General Meeting were discussed. It was quite apparent that very few members of our Guild wish to participate by volunteering to be on the Executive. This problem has to be addressed before next year, being that some of the Executive are not going to run again.
2. George Geurts advised that we have approximately \$3200.00 in the Bank.

4. We will no longer pay \$100.00 to our guest speakers or demonstrators. This was agreed upon by all Executive members.
5. Ian Fulford advised that we need to have a Set of Rules for Woodturning Competitions. These Rules would be applied and followed for any Competitions that FVWG are in charge of.

6. Gloria Herberts requested that more information should be accessible in regards to Competitions, times, dates, addresses, contacts, etc.. Apparently some of the Website Links to get information were unattainable.
