Minutes of Executive Meeting held on December 28th, 2005.

1. Sam Nelson advised that Colin Delory will do a demonstration on how to make a Chinese Ball. This is a 2 part demo, the second part will be continued at the February meeting.
2. Ian Fulford agreed to do a pen making demo in April.
3. May will be elections night and the rest of the evening will be Hands-on Turning. June has not been confirmed yet, we will advise by the next Newsletter.
4. Lance Murphy advised that there were only 25 persons signed up for the January dinner social that was to be held at the Ranchero in Abbotsford. We required a minimum of 50 persons to secure the private room. Due to insufficient interest in having the Social it will be cancelled.
5. The Executive discussed the possibility of a BBQ in September or the possibility of renting a Hall in January of 2007 for a family pot luck social.
6. Sam Nelson made a suggestion that we have an exchange of gifts for members who wish to participate. This would eliminate the Xmas Auction which has been spiralling downwards for the past few years.
7. The raffle ticket sales and proceeds are donated 50/50 to the Abbotsford Food Bank and the Care Bears of the World. The Executive motioned and approved that the Xmas auction be cancelled, since we won't be having a Social in December and the Guild is already donating monies to two worthy causes.
8. Colin Delory checked out prices on Sound Systems. The best one comes with a 6 year warranty, is very portable, and comes with speakers, microphone and a stand. The cost of this unit is approximately \$890.00. Colin Delory put the motion to the Executive, Bill Olsen seconded it and it was approved by the executive to purchase this unit so that the Guild will finally have a good sound system for our demo's and guest speakers.
9. Colin Delory advised that our Website gets approximately 400 hits per month. We thought that this was good, since we have about 45 e-mail members who have to read the Newsletter online.
10. It was agreed that our December meeting was a success and the members who did show up (some with there wives) had fun. We had 3 persons sign the guest book..
