

Fraser Valley Woodturners Guild – Demonstrator Certification

This form provides documentary evidence to record the assessment of a member of the FVWG in the knowledge and application of safe wood turning practices appropriate to the demonstration of wood turning demonstrations in public.

The form is required to be completed and signed by the Assessor and signed by the candidate Demonstrator at the successful completion of the Demonstrator Assessment process as described in the “Fraser Valley Woodturners Guild – Safety Assessment Process for Demonstrators”. It is the responsibility of the Assessor to pass the completed form to the Registrar for secure filing.

The validity of this certification is 5 years from the Assessor's signature date or as may be subsequently recommended by two current Assessors who shall bring their recommendations to the Board of Directors for a decision.
